(Strictly no entry after this time!)
Festival Ends: 22:30



TICKETS & ENTRY

To speed up entry, have your ticket downloaded to your phone or bring a printed copy before you arrive.



- **NO RE-ENTRY – ONCE YOU LEAVE, YOU CANNOT RETURN.**
- **BAG POLICY – STICK TO A4-SIZED BAGS OR SMALLER. PACK LIGHT!**
- **NO CAMPING TROLLEYS/LARGE WHEELED CARTS**

CAMPING CHAIRS

Camping chairs are allowed but must be positioned around the perimeter of the bowl. A map of designated seating areas will be available on our website.



HOW TO QUEUE LIKE A PRO AT REGGAE LAND

We know queuing isn't the most exciting part of the festival, but let's make it smooth, quick, and stress-free for everyone!



- **Stay compact, not single-file! – A tight, grouped queue helps security check tickets and bags more efficiently.**
- **Have your ticket & ID ready – No rummaging at the last second!**
- **Bringing a large bag? – You will be directed to a separate, longer queue for thorough security checks. To speed up entry, bring only what you need.**
- **Keep it moving! – Once security gives the green light, step forward swiftly to keep things flowing.**
- **Respect the vibes – No pushing, no cutting in, and no stopping mid-queue to check your phone!**

The sooner we all get inside, the sooner the vibes start flowing!

FIRST TIME AT REGGAE LAND?

HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

TOP TIPS

- ✓ Arrive early
Avoid last-minute queues.
- ✓ Stay with your group If you're arriving together, queue together!
- ✓ Large bags will delay entry
Stick to A4-sized bags or smaller.
- ✓ Respect others - Be mindful of personal space If you're moving through a crowd, be polite.
- ✓ Use bins provided
Help keep Reggae Land clean!
- ✓ Look out for one another – Let's make this a festival to remember for all the right reasons!
- ✓ Stay hydrated – Bring an empty plastic bottle (500ml max) and use our free refill stations.
- ✓ Plan your day – Check set times, food vendors, and explore the site.
- ✓ Have a meeting point – Mobile signal can be unreliable, so agree on a place to meet if you get separated.
- ✓ Go cashless – Reggae Land is cashless, so bring a debit/credit card or use phone payments.

WEATHER & WHAT TO WEAR

REGGAE LAND HAPPENS RAIN OR SHINE, SO BE PREPARED FOR ALL WEATHER CONDITIONS!

IF IT'S HOT



Wear sunscreen
Protect yourself from the sun.



Bring a hat & sunglasses
Keep cool and comfortable.



Stay hydrated – Free drinking water stations are available throughout the site. These are clearly signposted and easy to find.

IF IT'S RAINY



Pack a poncho - Small umbrellas are fine however large spiked umbrellas are not allowed due to safety reasons



Waterproof yourself - Light rain jackets are a good idea.

IF IT'S MUDDY



Wear sturdy shoes or waterproof boots
Trainers might not cut it if the ground gets wet!

IF IT'S GET'S CHILLY AT NIGHT



Bring a light layer – Temperatures can drop in the evening, so a hoodie or jacket will keep you comfortable.

Being prepared means you can focus on enjoying the festival.

GETTING TO REGGAE LAND 2025

There are multiple ways to travel to Reggae Land at The National Bowl, Milton Keynes.
We strongly encourage all staff and attendees to travel by public transport where possible. Plan ahead to avoid delays and ensure a smooth journey!

BY CAR



- On-site parking is available but must be pre-booked.
- Weekend parking ticket holders cannot leave until Sunday.
- Day parking ticket holders must leave after the event each day.
- No overnight camping or vehicle stays allowed.

PERSONAL ASSISTANT (PA) TICKETS & ACCESSIBLE AREAS

A 2:1 ticket scheme is available for those requiring a Personal Assistant (PA), along with a dedicated Access Area with facilities for those who need extra support. The deadline for submitting your access application is Friday 27th June. This is strict to ensure the access team has enough time to process and accommodate all requests before the festival.

ACCESSIBLE PARKING & TRAVEL

Pre-booked accessible parking is available, along with designated drop-off zones for easy access to the festival site. We have a site map on our website for you to easily see where the access car park is located.

FACILITIES & WELFARE

We offer accessible toilets, an Access Area, and medical/welfare services. All medications must be in sealed packaging and accompanied by a doctor's note or prescription matching your ID. Any medication requiring injection can be stored at the medical tent until needed.
